Memorial Service an Emotional Reminder

Monday, May 26th marked another Memorial Day to remember those lost in wars past and present for our freedoms as Americans. A brief service was held at the Rock Falls Cemetery in the evening, and was attended by approximately 30 residents. Mayor Lance Jost spoke briefly about the importance of remembering the true meaning of Memorial Day, Shirley Wyborny gave some brief history on fallen soldiers from Rock Falls, and Roger Hunt led the service with a few readings. The service was concluded with a gun salute by the American Legion, and Taps.



New Location Option for Post Office Boxes
