New Mayor Sworn In

Randy Dodd was sworn in as Mayor at the April council meeting. He has appointed Mark Brosz as Mayor Pro Tem in the event that Randy cannot fill his position. Mayor Dodd will fill this position until the end of the 2015 calendar year and can make the decision to run for the full-term in the November election.

Proposed 28E Agreement – Plymouth Fire Department

In March, the Plymouth Fire Department held a public hearing regarding the 28E Agreement it currently holds with Rock Falls and the surrounding townships. The current agreement has not been updated since it was written in 1982. The Fire Department is now asking for an increase in the annual amount based on a formula that gives a more balanced sharing among the entities that are getting fire protection.

This increase will be discussed by the City Council at the May meeting. The public is encouraged to attend. Council meetings are held on the second Monday of every month at 7pm in the Community Center.
