Waste Management Changes Proposed

Earlier in September, the city council received a letter from Waste Management regarding waste collection changes. The following proposal is an excerpt from the letter:

“At this time we would like to propose a change to the service day for your trash collection as well as a change to the city’s recycling collection. The trash would change from the current Tuesday service to a Monday service, with the recycling going from every week collection to every other week collection also serviced Mondays on the odd weeks of the month.

These changes would allow us to service the city with a much lighter automated side load truck instead of the heavier one pass truck that is currently being used to service the city. Changing the recycling services to every other week would also reduce truck traffic, without a reduction in the volume currently collected.”

The council appreciates your input in this decision. This matter will be brought to a vote by the council at the October council meeting. City council meetings are held the second Monday of every month at 7pm at the Community Center.
