In preparation for the upcoming conversion of all the users in Rock Falls to the fiber-optic equipment, OmniTel hosted an informational town meeting at the Community Center August 24.

A crowd of 50-60 persons gathered to hear a presentation from OmniTel personnel and ask questions regarding the expected new services.

It was explained that cabling has been laid to every structure in Rock Falls that has had phone service. However, from this point on anyone who would like to take advantage of OmniTel services needs to register with OmniTel by filling in a paper form or by registering via the internet. Once registered, OmniTel will connect whatever services, phone, internet, and cable TV,
